___ **New Orleans School of Cooking-** Their *entertaining 2 ½-hour classes and the Louisiana General Store are located in a renovated molasses warehouse built in the early 1800s in the heart of the French Quarter. They teach the basics of Louisiana Cooking. FUN is the primary ingredient! Creole/Cajun experts teach New Orleans specialties such as Gumbo, Jambalaya and Pralines, and season them with history, trivia and tall tales. \$27 fee includes lunch, coffee/tea/beer.*
